

## B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner.

I found a 1/2" Rebar without a cap as described by Ross. Corner falls 6' west of center of N-S road and 6' South of center of road to the west and on centerline of an ancient, 12' wide road berm to the east. A newer fence wanders east roughly in the center of this berm. This road intersection is in a cut/fill transition. No Edson witnescos exist. The stone was not found. All Ross witnesses are standing and measure OK.

I accept the 1/2" Iron as a careful and faithful perpetuation of the position of the original corner. No evidence is known to me that would lead me to believe that the corner should be at another location.
