B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner.

I found a 1/2" Iron at an old fence corner intersection E-W-S. Upon removal the Iron was found to be 40" long and appears to me to be a John Bean, circa 1880, iron as being of similar characteristic of other Bean irons that I have found. The Iron was found to be on the south side of ancient fence by Wetmore, 1912. One Wetmore witness is still standing at S40°W 3.6', and not S40°E.

I accept this iron as a careful and faithful perpetuation of the position of the original corner. No evidence is known to me that would lead me to believe
