

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner.

I found a 5/8" from 6" below the surface at the centerline intersection of E-W & S asphalt roads. Old occupation to the north begins 200' north of the corner. No OCRC witnesses are standing. Upon excavation and removal, the 5/8" Iron was found to be 13" long and was found to be a riser for a large odd-shaped fron approximately 2"x3" square with a small piece on the west side and that iron was found to be beside a stone of unknown size.

This Iron was accepted as the best evidence of the corner and was accepted as being a careful and faithful perpetuation of the original corner. No evidence is known to me that would lead me to believe that the corner should be in another location.

I set a 5/8"x36" Iron with a 2" aluminum cap stamped "Oceana County Remonumentation" and "26457" above the large iron at the position of the 5/8"x13" Iron riser.
