Richardson's K-1 position was set based on a fence corner as the North 1/8 corner on the East line of Section 2 with the North line on the I-1 to M-1 line.

It was recommended to accept the Richardson corner for K-1, set K-13 at the closing distance East of K-1, and set L-13 at single proportionate measure between K-13 and M-13. This would result in L-13 being 9.7' South and 5.9' West of the Consumer's corner set for L-13, and being 9.7' South of the Consumer's L-1 corner. This position was approved as the best available reestablishment of L-13 by the Ogemaw County Peer Review meeting on November 20, 1997.
