A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

The original corner was set by deputy surveyor Orson Lyons on 6 January 1837 Set wood post at 80.00 chains from South. peech 8" S53E 7 Lks. Beech 10" N50W 6

N50W 24 Lks.

From 1891 to 1904 approximately, Osceola County had a remonumentation program, in which surveyors Temple and Trumbull, did the work. For the most part, a 3" glazed tile filled with cinders from a forge, were placed at each government set corner in the township. There were supposed to be 3 tile per corner, placed atop of each other, (continued on back)

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner

Found 1" bar 18" long at surface. Removed bar and excavated to 22" and found 1 1/2" pipe placed Osceola County Monument over pipe 2" below surface

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

Corner C-6. Osceola County Monument, which is a 3" brass cap mounted MACEUNG 1" pipe 18" in length.
