B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring of reestablishing corner:

I found the 1/2" Capped Iron I sent in 1998. Corner is 8 feet West of the center of two-track road over earthen dam. In 1998 I talked to longtime resident Donald Marsh, who constructed the dam, and he said the corner was there when he built the dam. There is approximately 15 feet of fill over the corner location. The measurements East and West to the respective Section corners is 2608.51 feet. Corner is in line with an old tree line to the North.

Condition of the accessories are as follows: #1 Gone, #2 Gone, #3 Gone, #4 Gone, #5 Found in good condition, #6 Found in good condition, #7 Found in good condition, #8 Found in good condition.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

I replaced the ½" Capped Iron with a 1" x 30" Pipe with Osceola County Remon Cap, and is accepted as a careful and faithful of Mismig reestablishment of the position of the original corner.
