MDNR Mon & Post had been moved. The Mon. accepted the best available evidence of the position of the original corner. Reference Pt 'A' - FND. MDNR Mon. & Cedar Post - N 4° 19' E 13.13' of K3. Monument was facing W & up against post, not MDNR procedure. Monument agrees with Rec. Survey L. 479 P. 119-121 witnesses. Monument was apparently moved between 1979 and 1987. 2 of the witnesses on this Rec. Survey are the same BT's as LCRC L.2, P. 11 but different dimensions.
