- K-3 Sec. Cor. Common to Sec. 1,2, 11 & 12 FND. 3/4" x 3' long bent iron rod in 4" O.D. Vit. clay tile w/cinders per F. McClung and LCRC's and record surveys till 1979. MDNR Mon & Post had been moved. The Mon. accepted the best available evidence of the position of the original corner.
 - Reference Pt 'A' FND. MDNR Mon. & Cedar Post N 4° 19' E 13.13' of K3. Monument was facing W & up against post, not MDNR procedure. Monument agrees with Rec. Survey L. 479 P. 119-121 witnesses. Monument was apparently moved between 1979 and 1987. 2 of the witnesses on this Rec. Survey are the same BT's as LCRC L.2, P. 11 but different dimensions. Remove MDNR Mon & Cedar post and replace w/ 1/2" x24" Rebar. Monument established using improper procedures and is not utilized as K3 in this survey.
