From 1891 to 1904 approximately, Osceola County had a remonumentation program, in which surveyors Temple and Trumbull, did the work. For the most part, a 3" glazed tile filled with cinders from a forge, were placed at each government set corner in the township. Found 1/2" rod 2 feet long 4" below road surface. Found round top 5" Strap iron bar 5" below road surface. Bar is over 3 feet long about 3" to south. Excavated to 40", subsoil, and found no evidence of tile corner.
