B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

From 1891 to 1904 approximately, Osceola County had a remonumentation program, in which surveyors Temple and Trumbull, did the work. For the most part, a 3" glazed tile filled with cinders from a forge, were placed at each government set corner in the township. There were supposed to be 3 tile per corner, placed atop of each other, (continued on back)

Found 1/2" x 18" rod in monument box 3" below surface removed rod and monument box and excavated to 23 " and found 1/8" X 1" strap iron. Place Osceola County Monument in box 3" below surface. Corner is 8" North of centerline and is 5.25 West from Mecosta County Corner.
