From 1891 to 1904 approximately, Osceola County had a remonumentation program, in which surveyors Temple and Trumbull, did the work. For the most part, a 3" glazed tile filled with cinders from a forge, were placed at each government set corner in the township. There were supposed to be 3

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

Found Monument box 2.0 feet East of centerline of old U.S.. 131. Could not enter monument box, as I could not remove the cover, no slot to pry. Acts as if an additional ring has been added, as the whole top is loose, and cover will loosen.
