Beech 10" N24.5°E 25L., Hemlock 7" S78°E 11L.  From 1891 to 1904 approximately, Osceola County had a remonumentation program, in which surveyors Temple and Trumbull, did the work. For the most part, a 3" glazed tile filled with cinders from a forge, were placed at each government set corner in the township. There were supposed to be 3 tile per corner, placed atop of each other, thereby making the corner 4 feet long. Sometimes a solid tile, with a cross in the top was used, and sometimes a iron bar or pipe was added to the tile.
