Set 1" x 36" galv. iron pipe with 4" DNR Alum. Cap by Wit. at stone and crockery pile. This position is believed to have been perpetuated by Co. Surveyor Frank Trumbull in the 1904 and is accepted as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner.		Reference PtJ - Found LLS cap #30079 on 1/2" X 18" rerod per unrecorded LCRC - N26°10'E 22.94' of E-2. 0.4' NNE is face of 4" dia. steel fence post for fences N, S & W. P. Case indicates he found Co.
