- B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:
- $\frac{1-3}{\times}$ Sec.cor. common to Sec. 2,3,10 & 11- Found LS Cap # 25862 on 1/2" \times 18" rebar in 6" dia. rotten cedar anchor post bottom per LCRC in agreement with 2 Co. BT Pine Stp's. This position is believed to have been perpetuated by Co. Surveyor F. Trumbull in the early 1900's and is accepted as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner.
