

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

<u>L-3</u> - 1/4 cor. common to Sec.1 & 12- Set 4" DNR Alum. Cap on 1" x36" galv. iron pipe in ring of stone from the remains of two Co. Survey BT stumps. Position falls 33' + I- N of fence remains W & E. A NE-SW motorcycle trail is 41' SE. This position is believed to have been perpetuated by Co. Surveyor F. Trumbull in the early 1900's and is accepted as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

L-3 - DNR Monument per part 'B' with carsonite guard post 1' S \$22°E 17.84' to set spike in CL. 24" Pine Stp. remains (Old NBT) \$37°W 30.39' to set spike in CL. 16" Pine Stp. remains (Old NBT) \$45°W 72.30' to set N&T in N side Tw. 12" Beech scribed 'XBT' \$21°W 125.98' to set N&T in SE side 21" W. Oak scribed 'XBT' \$29°E 30.64' to set N&T in SW side 2" R. Maple N5°W 26.20' to set N&T in W side 2" R. Maple
