В.	The original corner was set by deputy surveyor John Hodgson on Dec. 11, 1837. Set wood post 80.00 chains from the Southeast Corner of Section 31. Beech 10" S75W 69 lks. Beech 14" N29W 54 lks. From 1891 to 1904 approximately, Osceola County had a remonumentation program, in which surveyors Temple and Trumbull, did the work. For the most part, a 3" glazed tile filled with cinders from a forge, were placed at each government set corner in the township. There were supposed to be 3 tile per corner, placed atop of each other, (continued on back)

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thereby making the corner 4 feet long. Sometimes a solid tile, with a cross in the top was used, and sometimes a 1/2" iron bars were added to the tile. Notes of the work were kept in ledgers, and given to the townships, and 5 of the townships have been recorded in the County records.

This corner is recorded in the Cedar Twp. Book pages 44 & 45, about 1915. PA. 74 Certificate, dated 12-10-77, by K. Ostling.
