B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring of reestablishing corner: I found R. Hayes 1/2" capped iron 30 feet South of a old East-West fence (down) and 33 feet more or less West of an old fence running North and South. I disregarded this corner because it was set improperly; surveyor Hayes used the wrong corners in all four directions. In 1997, Matt McClung, Co. Sur., found a 1/2" rod (standing well above the ground level) next to a fence post 30 feet North of Hayes's corner. He thought the position of this 1/2" rod should be held for the corner (there was traces of an old fence running South from this 1/2" rod). I visited the site with Mr. McClung at that time (by his request) and we decided further investigation into the North-South fence, which is 33 feet East of this found 1/2" rod, should be done. On October 20, 2000, I took a front-end loader and backhoe and excavated the entire area looking for the 3" Clay Tile, which I did not recover. The fence line, 33 feet East of the 1/2" Iron McClung found, runs for a mile South and a mile North. The 1/4 corner and Section corner (both recovered tiles) South of this corner position are both in this old fence line. The 1/4 corner North of this position is also in this fence line. I set the corner in this fence line and in line with the old fence to the West. This position fits well with 1/16 line occupation (fence line) to the North. I firmly believe the traces of fence line, which are 33 feet West was a right of way fence.

Condition of the accessories are as follows: #1 Gone, #2 Gone, #3 Found in good condition, #4 Found in good condition, #5 Gone, #6 Found in good condition.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner: I set a 1" x 18" pipe with Osceola County Remon Cap, and is accepted as a careful and faithful reestablishment of the position of the original 35000
