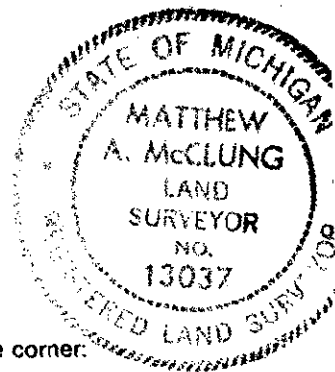
**A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:**

The original corner was set by deputy surveyor Sylvester Sibley on July 7, 1838. Set wood post 36.5 chains from the West.  
Hemlock 7" N7W 7 lks.  
Sugar 12" S1E 19 lks.

From 1891 to 1904 approximately, Osceola County had a remonumentation program, in which surveyors Temple and Trumbull, did the work. For the most part, a 3" glazed tile filled with cinders from a forge, were placed at each government set corner in the township. There were supposed to be 3 tile per corner, placed atop of each other, (continued on back)

**B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:**

Found 1 1/4" solid iron shaft @ 15 Mile Rd. surface. Dug finding clay tile chip & Pieces to 1.10' here. I found a 3" clay tile removed shaft from tile. Set Osceola County Monument into tile Set at 0.4 depth.



**C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:**

Corner B-7 Osceola County Monument, which is a 3" brass cap mounted on a 1" pipe 18" in length.  
5" crabapple N50W 36.5 feet O.B.T.  
Power Pole N08W 74.4 feet  
1" Northern Pine N58E 47.4 feet  
12" Elm S85W 112.5 feet
