B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring of reestablishing corner:

I found the ½" rod used in 1978. I also found the 3" Clay Tile which was East 1.55 feet from the ½" rod. I accepted the 3" clay tile as the correct corner. I removed the 1/2" iron rod. Corner is in line with fences East and West and is in the center of a North and South road.

Condition of the accessories are as follows: #1 Gone, #2 Gone, #3 Found in good condition, #4 Found in good condition, #5 Found in good condition.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

I set a 1-1/2" pipe with an Osceola County Remon Cap in the center of the Clay tile and is accepted as a careful and faithful Reestablishment of the position of the original corner.
