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A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration: The corner was set by deputy surveyor Sylvester Sibley on July 7, Set wood post 80.00 chains from the South.

From 1891 to 1904 approximately, Osceola County had a remonumentation program, in which surveyors Temple and Trumbull, did the work. For the most part, a 3" glazed tile filled with cinders from a forge, were placed at each government set corner in the township. There were supposed to be 3 tile per corner, placed atop of each other, (continued on back)

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

Excavated to 6" and found 1/2" rod. Excavated to 8" and Tile. Placed Osceola County Monument over rod in tile 6" below road surface. West of center line.
