A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

The original corner was set by deputy surveyor Sylvester Sibley on July 7, 1838. Set wood post 39.90 chains from the East. Sugar 7" S86.5E 22 lks. Sugar 14" N20W 25 lks.

From 1891 to 1904 approximately, Osceola County had a remonumentation program, in which surveyors Temple and Trumbull, did the work. For the most part, a 3" glazed tile filled with cinders from a forge, were placed at each government set corner in the township. There were supposed to be 3 tile per corner, placed atop of each other, (continued on back)

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

Found Male end of sucker rod 5" below surface. Removed sucker rod and excavated to 27" and found 5/8" bar. At 30" found 3" clay tile. Set Osceola County Monument over clay tile 6" below Road surface.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner. Corner F-7. Osceola County Monument, which is a 3" brass cap mounted on a 1" pipe 18" in length.

Power Pole NO2W 77.85 feet.

Power Pole S70W 117.75 feet.

thereby making the corner 4 feet long. Sometimes a solid tile, with a cross in the top was used, and sometimes a 1/2" iron bars were added to the tile. Notes of the work were kept in ledgers, and given to the townships, and 5 of the townships have been recorded in the County records.

This corner has 1 LCRC certificate recorded, by McClung.

This corner has 4 PA 132 recordings 3 by McClung and one by Ray.
