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A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

1838, Lewis Clason, Deputy Surveyor, intersected the North boundary 24 links West of post and set post. Witnesses marked: (S 89° E 21 links 10" Beech) (S 19° W 36 links 22" Sugar).

1924, Guy R. Veal, Dependent Resurvey, set an iron post, 3' long, 2" diam., 42" in ground, for reestablished closing corner of Sections 4 and 5, with brass cap. Witnesses marked: (S 4°-30' E 159 links, dist. mkd. T 25 N, R 2 E, S. 4 C.C. B.T. 6" Ash) (S 54°-30' W 70 links, dist. mkd. T 25 N, R 2 E, S. 5 C.C. B.T. 6" Poplar).

8-18-1953, George D. Henning, P.S. #2240, found GLO corner. No data available.

5-1964, Norman C. Caldwell, P.S. #12018, set 2" pipe & cap as perpetuation of U.S. GLO monument. Survey Recorded on 9-12-1964. No witnesses marked.

2-1966, Norman C. Caldwell, P.S. #12018, found 2" pipe & cap as perpetuation of U.S. GLO monument. Survey Recorded on 10-4-1966. No witnesses marked.

3-12-1969, Norman C. Caldwell, P.S. #12018, found 2" pipe replaced in pavement by Norman Caldwell, R.L.S. in a survey dated April and May 1964, from data on Henning survey. GLO monument not located due to extreme fill area of road construction. Witnesses marked: (S 8° E 99.0' 6" Oak) (N 67° E 100.0' 12" Apple) (South 33.0' 1 bar). Recorded L. 2, P. 21, Oscoda County Records Corner Registry. Corner of Sections 32 and 33, T 26 N, R 2 E, and is 15.8' East.

11-11-1994, Larry G. Beauregard, P.S. #18654, found 2" pipe & cap. Witnesses marked: (S 5° E 38.92' 4" Elm) (South 32.44' Red top post [USFS]). (S 25° W 34.32' 9" Elm). Southwest corner of Section 33, T 26 N, R 2 E, East 15.8 existing 2" pipe & cap (R).

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

Existing 2" pipe in place, set by Norman C. Caldwell in 1964, 15.92' (M) East 15.80' (R) to Section corner 32 and 33, T 26 I R 2 E.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

Closing corner for Sections 4 and 5, T 25 N, R 2 E

Oscoda County Remonumentation cap P.S. #18654 on a 5/8" x 18" bar inside a 2" x 12" pipe, this all being inside a monument box. Accepted as a careful and faithful establishment of the position of the corner. Approved by the Peer Group on July 1. NGC 16 5EPT 95 1995.
