Larry G. Beauregard . in a field survey on March 13, do hereby certify that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and/or that the comer points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Professional Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established, re-established, monumented, re-monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

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Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration: Witnesses marked: (N 45° E 20 links 8-8-1838, Lewis Clason, Deputy Surveyor, set post corner Sections 32 and 33. 14" Hd. Maple) (N 62° W 40 links 10" Hemlock).

9-28-1914, C.O. Seeley, County Surveyor, found U.S. B.T. (N 62° W 40 links 10" Hemlock-down and partly decayed) (N 45° E 20 links 14" Maple, gone). Set new post and iron pipe at old stake. New bearings stone monument of 5 large stones (post buried) (N 34° W .32 links). NBT: (S 7° W 3.94 links 30" W. Pine stump).

1924, Guy R. Veal, Dependent Resurvey, found the true point for the corner of Sections 32 and 33, as perpetuated by Rai and Seeley, County Surveyors, whose notes are on file in the county records. The point is marked by an iron post,  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " diam., set with top 2" below road surface, set by Seeley in 1915. North and along side the iron pipe, I set an iron pa 3' long, 2" diam., 42" in ground for reestablished corner of Sections 32 and 33. No bearing trees available, pits impr ticable.
