Guy R. Veal in 1935 found the point for the corner of Secs. 14, 15, 22 & 23, which was marked by an iron pipe 2" x 6" above ground at the corner of fences bearing E, W and N and fence line bearing S. The corner is said by Mr. N. Angel, a nearby resident, to have been perpetuated by a former County Surveyor from an original B.T.. Set a brass tablet $3_2^{1"}$ diam., 3" stem, in a conc. mon., 24" long, 6" diam., 18" in ground for corner with top marked Secs. 14, 15, 22 and 23.
