- A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:
 - (K-5) Post corner set Sections 11, 12, 13 and 14 by William R. Coon in 1839.

 Wits: 8" Spruce Pine S 44° E 3 links 6" Spruce Pine N 16° W 22 links

Clarence Seeley in 1909 found corner previously established by E.M. Power Co. No witnesses marked.

Guy R. Veal in 1935 found the point for corner of Sections 11, 12, 13 and 14 which is marked by an iron pipe 1" \times 6" above ground. This corner has long been in existence and accepted by all interested parties, is harmoniously related to other existing corners and is accepted as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner. Set a brass tablet $3\frac{1}{2}$ " diam., 3" stem in conc. mon. 24" long, 6" diam., 18" in ground and marked top will Secs. 11, 12, 13 and 14. Government Deputy Surveyor. Dependent Resurvey of T 26 N, R 2 E. Local B.T.s: (16" Norway Pine N 10° E 105 links) (14" Norway Pine N 55° W 151 links). Wits marked: (10" J. Pine S $38\frac{1}{2}$ ° 169 links) (5" J. Pine S $41\frac{1}{2}$ ° W distance not recorded).

Norman C. Caldwell P.S. #12018 in 1967 found U.S. GLD mon. at back edge of road ditch on curve. No references marked. West 198.0' (now conc. mon.) Corner registry, L. 2, P. 107.

Cliff Lindgren P.S. #14098 in 1993 found GLO mon. West 198.0' $\frac{1}{2}$ " bar on Section line & recorded corner on 5-3-93 Found 4" square mon. with hole in center (part of top broken off). Monument checks with $\frac{1}{2}$ " bar West 198.03'. (T. Pole S 60° W 27.86') (P. Guy Pole N 30° W 21.70') (24" R. Pine N 15° E 69.28') (16" Dak N 60° E 88 Found hole in conc. mon. with part of top broken off. Witnessed corner in 1992. Corner was covered with 2' dir during construction in 1993. Found monument to be in correct position & set $\frac{1}{2}$ " re-rod with RLS cap stamped MDOT #14098 over monument & 8" above ground. $\frac{1}{2}$ " re-rod with cap MDOT #14098 over hole in conc. mon. Wits marked: ($\frac{1}{2}$ " re-rod (prop. iron) West 198.03') (N: tag in G. Pole N 35° W 21.68') (24" R. Pine Ex. Hwy. N. tag in N 15° E 69.32') (15" Dak Ex. Hwy. N. tag in N 60° E 88.92').

- B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:
- (K–5) Found $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 30" bar & P.S. cap #14098 (MDOT) over u.S. GLO mon. 8" above ground. Replaced bar & cap with Standar Oscoda Co. corner, 3" brass cap on 1" x 2" pipe.
- C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:
- (K-5) Section corner common to Sections 11, 12, 13 and 14, T 26 N, R 2 E

Placed standard Oscoda Co. monument, 3° brass cap on 1° x 2° pipe over U.S. GLO monument, and is accepted as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner.
