1883, John Randall, Deputy County Surveyor, found original corner. No data available.

1915, C.O. Seeley, County Surveyor, found no evidence of original corner. Reestablished intervening corners by proportic measurement. No data available.

1924, Guy R. Veal, Dependent Resurvey, the original corner of Sections 35 and 36 was found by Randall, in 1883. C.O. Sec County Surveyor, executed a re-survey of the Township line in 1915. Seeley found no evidence of the original corner beta the corner of Townships 25 and 26N, Ranges 2 and 3E, and the corner of Sections 34 and 35, S. boundary of T 26 N, R 2 E; reestablished intervening corners by proportional measurement. His corners are accepted by me only when his record shows that sure evidence of the original survey was found. Set iron post 3' long, 2" diam., 27" in ground for reestablished corner of Sections 35 and 36.
