This point has long been recognized by all interested parties as the true point for the corner is harmoniously related to existing original corners and is accepted as the best available evidence of the original corner. Set a brass tablet $3\frac{1}{2}$ " diam., 3" stem in conc. mun. 24" long, 6" diam., 30" in ground in road for the $\frac{1}{4}$ section corner with top marked Secs. 24 & 25. Local BT's: (16" Basswood 5 75° E 159 links). Wits: (18" Sugar Maple N $34\frac{1}{4}$ ° E 141½ links (not marked). Government Deputy Surveyor. Dependent Resurvey of T 26 N, R 2 E.

Norman C. Caldwell P.S. #12018 in 1966 found U.S. GLO mon. raised with 3/4" pipe to surface of roadway. Wits: (30" Basswood S 75° E 103.41) (24" Maple N 34° E 92.01) (P. Pole S 55° W 94.11) Corner Registry file L. 2. P. 118.

Norman C. Caldwell P.S. #12018 in 1973 found 3/4" pipe over GLO mon. & witnesses marked by himself in 1966. LCRC recorded L. 1, P. 110.
