B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner: C-13 Southeast Corner Section 31

Fd. standard DNR monument with square wood post (down) 135' South of centerline trail road, Fd. S. Pine 11" N15°W 46.35', Fd. J. Pine 8" N75°E 47.5' (blown down, dead), Fd. S. Pine 8" S18°W 51.0' (blown down, dead)

This corner was restored using Double Proportionate measure by Ken Ostling for the following reason, "This method was used in recognition of the total measurement available between corners, rather than single proportionate method, which would place a considerable overrun in Section 5 at the expense of Section 32."

Fd. 5/8" pipe, 32" long, with a 1-3/4" knuckle broken off the top at the South edge of the trail road.

Fd. 1/2"x36" long rebar next to pipe. Pipe is 132.3' North and 8.5' East of the DNR Monument. Origin of pipe and rebar is unknown.

Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner: C-13 Southeast Corner Section 31

Fd. Standard DNR monument is accepted as a careful and faithful reestablishment of the position of the original corner.
