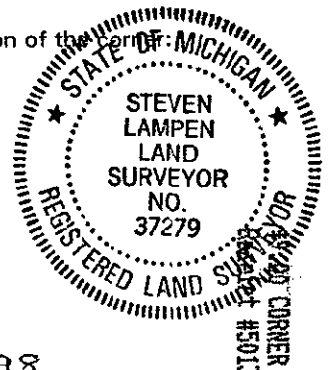
B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

C-12 Found iron pipe and old wood corner fence post
C-12 to C-13 measure 2671 feet
C-12 is 3.8 feet. West of C-11 to C-13
Set Ottawa County remonumentation iron and cap over found iron pipe and is accepted as a careful and faithful perpetuation of the position of the original corner.
