B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner.

(L2) Found no evidence of prior monumentation at the corner position. Established the corner at the intersection of straight lines connecting opposite 1/4 corners. The South 1/4 corner of Section 1 falls in the Bond Falls Flowage. It's unmonumented position was determined by proportionate measurement, according to the original record between the SW and SE corners of Section 1. At the position for the corner I placed a 1° I.D. x 32° iron pipe capped with a 4° dia. cast aluminum MDNR tablet, appropriately stamped. Corner placed and witnessed by B.Wheeler and D.Lampela, Baraga District Office.

(M1) Recovered the 1986 monument, as described, in good condition, and at substantial record bearing and distance from the 1986 witnesses, all recovered. The Balsam ME has fallen over but still lives. Did not recover any remains of the original BTs noted in the 1986 record. Left the monument in place and marked two new mitnesses as described below. Corner recovered and mitnessed by B.Mheeler and D.Lampela, Baraga District Office.
