A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

(K-4) 1/2 Corner Common to Sections 11 & 12, T47N, R38W

1851 - Zelotes B. Searls set a post.

1889 - Plat of Josephine shows a distance of 1008.30 feet from the North line of the railroad right-of-way to this corner. (1059.86 feet calculated to centerline.)

1891 - Plat of Trout Creek shows a distance of 2643.00 feet from the Southwest Corner of Section 12 to this corner.

1946 - Supervisor's Plat No. 1 of the Southwest 1/4 of Section 12, T47N, R38W, shows a distance of 1529.85 feet from the Southwest Corner of Section 12 to the South line of the railroad right-of-way. (1581.41 feet calculated to the centerline.)

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

I found no remains of the original Corner or accessories. North-South Division Street now runs over the area of the 1/4 Corner. I calculated a position for the Corner using Plat Monumentation in the Plat of Trout Creek. Distance South to the centerline of the abandoned railroad grade works reasonably well with distance called for in Plat of Josephine (1062 feet, measured). This position works well with surveys in the Plat of Trout Creek and works well with Section Comers to North and South. I monumented it as the 1/2 Corner.

Research on file with County Remonumentation Representative.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

Corner is a 5/8" iron pin with a 3" diameter aluminum cap stamped: COUNTY REMONUMENTATION; 1/4; S.11, S.12; T,47N, R,38W; 1998; P.S. 37273. I also established a reference monument (R.M.) to the Southeast, a 1/2" x 36" aluminum rod with 3" diameter aluminum cap stamped to indicate that the 1/2 Corner is N 86° W a distance of 24.42 feet.
