

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

No original evidence was found. Occupied land with old fence (50 plus years) were checked a mile South and $\frac{1}{2}$ mile North. These agree with original calls. Measuring East and West one mile agree with original calls. Corner was established at the intersection of the centerline of the blacktop road and the occupied line running West. This is 20± North of the centerline of a gravel road running East.

Research is on file with the Ontonagon County Remonumentation Representative.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corners

At the corner position I set a 5/8"X24" rebar with a $3\frac{1}{4}"$ aluminum cap (insulated from the steel), 2" below top of blacktop. Cap is stamped to read: County Remonumentation, S25, S30, S31, S36, T48N R40W & R39W, 1996, P.S. 17610. I established one reference monument, a $2\frac{1}{2}$ "X30" aluminum pipe with a $3\frac{1}{4}$ " stamped cap and three other reference objects.
