

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

No evidence of original corner or bearing trees were found. At the corner position there was a $\frac{1}{2}$ " Iron Re-bar flush with the blacktop surface. There is a four way road intersection at the corner position. The $\frac{1}{2}$ " Iron Pin was used for several surveys in the area. I accepted the $\frac{1}{2}$ " Iron Pin as the corner location and remonumented the corner as described in "C" below.

C. Description of monument for comer and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:...

At the corner position I set a $3\frac{1}{4}$ " stamped aluminum cap over the $\frac{1}{2}$ " Re-bar in of Michigan and insulated the two metals with a plastic insert. Cap is 3" below top of blacktop. Cap is stamped to read: COUNTY REMONUMENTATION, S30, S31, EARL W.
