

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

No original evidence was found. Michigan Dept. of Transportation Highway prints, dated 1963 identify the corner as a 1" Iron Rod 2640.03 feet North of the Section corner near the center-line of the highway. I did not find the Iron Rod but did find two ties on fence posts which were with on the ground. The position identified by MDOT agrees with a woods field line running East. I placed the corner at the position indicated by MDOT. This position is within 6 feet of a split of the Section.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:
