



NO original evidence was found. A power line turns East & West just South of the apparent corner position. A 1" pipe and a 14" pipe was found South of the power line and South of the calculated corner position.

Corner was re-established by single proportionate measurement and on line between opposite section corners.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner;
