

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

07-08-96

No original evidence was found. At the apparent corner position there are fences running in all four directions. An old roadbed runs East for one mile. The location is in conformance with the original field notes. The corner was re-established using the evidence found at the site. The location of the section corners North, East and West were known and used to verify the location of this corner.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

AT the corner position I set a $2\frac{1}{2}$ "X30" aluminum pipe with a $3\frac{1}{4}$ " cap stamped to read: County Remonumentation, T47N, T48N, R40W, S2, S3, S34, S35, 1996, P.S. 17610. I established three bearing trees and a reference object.
