

At the apparent corner I found a fence running in all four directions and a 1" Drill Steel set at this location. This Drill Steel was set by E.W. Applekamp, P.S. 17610 in July 1982 to describe 8 parcels of land in the West  $\frac{1}{2}$  of Section 36. The land occupied in all four directions from this corner position. I accepted the location of the 1" Drill Steel as being the true location of the corner.
