

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

No original evidence was found. Occupied land with old fence (50 plus years) were checked a mile South and $\frac{1}{2}$ mile North. These agree with original calls. Measuring East and West one mile agree with original calls. Corner was established at the intersection of the centerline of the blacktop road and the occupied line running West. This is a 20th North of the centerline of a gravel road running East.
