B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

Corner location is on a gravel road. The area East of the road is a field. A well maintained fence runs East from this location with dwelling on the North & South. The location is consistent with the original field notes. An iron pipe was found 30 feet West of the corner location. No object was found in the roadway. I set a monument in the road and a Witness monument at the corner location as described in "C" below.
