

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

A survey by E.W. Applekamp in 1971 indicates a 11 Iron Pipe was at the corner. Ties were on the survey but no pipe was found. The location was in the centerline of a road running East and a fence line running West. It was in the West lane of a road running North & South. I accepted the position and set a monument as described below. This corner was one of the corners remonumented in a Block of 6 Sections in which all original corners were re-established.
