Survey by Austin Burt, Deputy Surveyor, 1848 - Set sugar post from which:

Fir 8 - \$45°W, 35 links (23.1 feet) Hemlock 12 - N25°E, 15 links (9.90 feet)

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

Taping east from the monumented corner at 20, 21, 28 and 29, I established a search area at the one-qurter corner. I recovered the hemlock B.T. now a 24"- 30" decayed stump. This corner position is N89°-59'-56"E, 2632.03 feet from the N.W. corner of Section 28. The position matches very good with the 990 foot call east to a swamp which is an abrupt thick cedar swamp. Taping west 722 feet I recovered a 24" ± yellow birch stump (decayed) at record distance for the line tree, originally a 10" Y. birch, from my corner position.

This corner position is approximately S2°W - 16 feet from a blazed and painted tree Keweenaw is using as the one-quarter corner.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

I set a 3/4" diameter x 4 foot long aluminum rod with a 3" aluminum cap stamped T48N, R42W, one-quarter corner, S-21, S-28, 1995, RLS 28410, from which I established the following bearing trees/objects:

12" maple - N26°W - 11.55 feet 12" maple - S51°E - 11.40 feet 12" maple - S56°W - 19.12 feet

Steel rail with sign - N60°E - 1.48 feet
