B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

I found no remains of the original corner or accessories. At the 1/4 corner position I found a 1" iron pipe 15' west of centerline of an old logging road. This pipe falls within 5.6' of a single prorated position and appears to have been used and accepted as the 1/2 corner for many years. I have accepted the 1" iron pipe as best representing the original position of the GLO ¼ corner. I placed a ¾" aluminum rod with cap inside of the existing pipe.
