B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner.

Neal Sperhake, RLS recovered the original Hemlock bearing tree at \$20°E, 31 Links on 11-1-61. At the corner position he set a 1"X36" long iron pipe monument with a 4" diameter cast aluminum cap, stamped to indicate corner position. He established four new bearing trees: Hemlock 14" N64°W 31 Links, Cedar 14" M18°E 37 Links, Cedar 16" \$46°E 31 Links, Hemlock 10" \$73°W 40 Links. On October 12, 1978, Richard Drahn, RLS 21564 verified the position of Sperhake's monument from the remains of the original Hemlock bearing trees. He found Sperhake's four bearing trees and filed an Act 74 Certificate which was recorded on April 25, 1979 in Liber 1, Page 131.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner.

In September 1999 I used the corner and found the monument to be in excellent condition. Three of the bearing trees set by Sperhake are in good condition. The 16" Cedar S46°E 31 Links, has been cut down. The monument set by Sperhake is 1½ feet above ground and has a Steel Sign Post S40°W 1.25 feet. I established one new bearing tree. Nail in a
