B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

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At the corner location I found a 1" galvanized pipe with a 4" cap stamped Kimberly Clark Corporation, T48N R43W, 10, 11, 7-28-76, RLS 14765. The monument projects 6'' above ground. I found an Aspen and a Black Ash tree, which were called for as ties to the corner. The corner monument agreed with the bearing and distance given to the two bearing trees. I accepted this as the proper location for the corner and updated the accessories as shown in "C" below.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:
