

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

No original evidence of post or bearing trees were found. A stream call on the original notes 640 feet North of corner, agrees with the location of the re-established corner. The corner was re-established at the latitude of the Section Corner 1 mile East and a $\frac{1}{4}$ Corner $\frac{1}{2}$ mile West. Departure of the corner was set at a proportional distance using the same two corners. Total distance differed by 15 feet compared to original notes. I established the monument described in "C" below.
