Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

No original evidence can be found due to logging activity, road and utility construction.

Found a 1 1/2" iron pipe (bent) marking the corner position. This corner position has been used for many years by several surveyors. Local residents agree to it being the section corner and is the only possible corner position due to all the development referenced to it.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

I updated the corner position to state and county specifications by setting a 5/8" x 24" rebar with a 3 1/4" aluminum cap 3" below the pved road surface stamped: County Remonumentation; S-1; S-12; S-6; S-7; T48N, R43W, R42W; 1994; RLS 28410. I established the following bearing trees and reference objects: A reference monument consisting of a 2 1/2" x 30" aluminum pipe with a 3 1/4" aluminum cap stamped to indicate the comer position - Due east - 41.76 feet with a 6' steel rail with sign 0.92 feet away; light pole - N41"W, 40.17 feet; 12" maple - S65 E, 52.95 feet; 6" maple - S30°W, 37.18 feet.
