I. Earl W. Applekamp, in a field survey on June 24 do hereby certify that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and/or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Professional Surveyors or by a

Section Corner common to Sections 28, 29, 32 & 33, T49N R41W.

Decree of a Court of Law; established, re-established, monumented, re-monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

NOTE: Not more than 4 corners, all in the same town and range, may be recorded on this certificate.

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

Original corner established by S.W. Higgins, U.S. Deputy Surveyor, summer 1847. Set Post.

BEARING TREES:

12" Cedar N44°E 8 links (5.28 feet) 18" White Pine S10°W 10 links (6.60 feet)

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner.

No evidence of the original corner was found. There is an old road running N & S through this corner location which has been in existence since the early 1900's. A 40 acre parcel of land was homesteaded $\frac{1}{2}$ mile North. a well defined clearing line was found to be $\frac{1}{2}$ mile North of the corner location. A blazed and painted line 15 years old runs West from the corner location. I personally remember a 4"x4" yellow tag on a tree a few feet East of the corner location. I traveled this road numerous times during the last 30 plus years and being a surveyor was conscious of the tag. The tag was not found when this corner was set. I accepted the corner position based on the evidence found and set a monument described in "C" below.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner in the corner position I set a 2½"x30" aluminum pipe with a 3¼" cap 3" below top of dirt road. Cap is stamped to read: COUNTY REMONUMENTATION APPLEKAMP S28, S29, S32, S33, T49N R41W, 1995, P.S. 17610. I established the following trees and reference objects:
