

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

No original evidence was found. In 1912 a R.O.W. for a road was cleared from Bergland to the Cascade Creek. The road was never built in this area of the corner, but apparently the bearing trees were destroyed when the R.O.W. was cut. I re- established the corner by single proportionate measure between corners North and South and in the Center-line of the cleared R.O.W.

I established three bearing trees and a reference object.
