Birch still scribed. Donald D. Lappala, RLS 12585 on 6/24/70 restored the corner from the remains of the two original B.T.s and Brothertons tag/B.T. He set a 2½" dia. iron pipe with a 3" stamped brass cap and the following new B.T.s: --- 13" (13") Sugar Maple N.41 W.(N.41 W.) 29.7' (29.77') ---7" (10") Black Ash N.72 E. (N.75E.) 30.6' (30.55') --- 7" (11") White Ash S.65 W. (S.66 W.) 21.5' (21.46') ---

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

Corner recorded in Ontonagon County in USFS Liber, Page A-5 on 9/14/72.

Recovered the monument as described and the bearing trees as noted in parentheses above.
