He set a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " dia. iron pipe with a 3" stamped brass cap and the following new B.T.s: --- 9" (10") Yellow Birch N.62 W. (N.61 W.) 49.1' (49.04') --- 9" (13") Cedar N.58-30 E. (N.57 E.) 54.1' (54.11') --- 9" Cedar (14") S.09-30 W. (S.08 W.) 5.4' (5.17') ---Corner recorded in Ontonagon County in USFS Liber, Page X-9 on 9/14/72.
